Ministry and Personnel Committee Training Requirements

All Communities of Faith are required to have a functioning Ministry and Personnel Committee. The Human Resources Commission of Antler River Watershed, Horseshoe Falls, and Western Ontario Waterways Regional Council have approved the following policies:

Requirements while undergoing a search for new ministry personnel (excluding short-term supply).

That Pastoral Charges must have an M&P committee of no less than three members prior and that all members of the M&P committee need to have undergone M&P training within the last three years prior to a new call or appointment being approved.

General Requirements

All members of the M&P committee must undergo training at least every five years.

To help with this training the Human Resources Commissions offer the following

- M&P Committee Training offered at least twice a year.
- M&P Committee Training videos available for M&P Commissions to undergo their own training.
